

Summary of [CDC Travel Guidance](#)

Travel Review: Travel guidance has been updated 12/6. NH will no longer have NH specific travel guidance, but instead follow CDC.

- Pre Travel Guidance
  - **Domestic**
    - Recommended to get tested with a viral test 1-3 days before your trip if NOT fully vaccinated
  - **International** \*travel requirements differ for non US citizens, below guidance is just recapping US citizens
    - Recommended to check your destination's COVID-19 situation and travel requirements before traveling. Countries may have their own entry and exit requirements.
- After Travel Guidance
  - **Domestic**
    - Recommended to self-monitor for symptoms. Isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms
    - Recommended If you are NOT fully vaccinated, seek testing 3-5 days after travel
  - **International** \*travel requirements differ for non US citizens, below guidance is just recapping US citizens
    - **Required: All air passengers, regardless of vaccination status, must show a negative COVID test no more than 1 day before travel**
    - Recommended to get tested 3-5 days after travel
    - Recommended Self-monitor for symptoms and isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms
    - Recommended If you are NOT fully vaccinated, stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if you test negative on day 3-5
      - If you don't get tested, stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel
