What is your preferred number of years required for the Pricing Solution, e.g. 1 Year, 3 Years, 5 Years?

10.What is the domain number that CMS should maintain? Nashua.edu

11.Is there a specified maximum budget? No, there is not a specific maximum budget.

12. Which existing applications need to be integrated with the new CMS? The NSD student database is integrated into the mass communication notification system.

13.Are there any third-party application integrations? Yes, the third-party facilities rental software and employment software is linked to nashua.edu. The degree of integration is not extensive.

14.Are there any specific security compliance requirements like PCI, HIPAA, Fed-RAMP, and others? Yes.

15.Is to have "developed a positive track record with the City of Nashua to the extent the bidder has previously provided goods or services" obligatory or can it be omitted in case of good performance of RFP? Yes, it can be omitted.

16.Could you please clarify the requested maintenance duration, if the development duration is from the 15th of July to the 25th of November (up to 6 months)? Yes, six months in development is expected. Please note the addendum that was posted today that pushed out the RFP timeline three weeks.

17.Do you prefer to use automatic translation, as is currently implemented using Google Translate, or do you prefer to completely control the localization of content for the new version of the site? We looking to use automatic translation but not necessarily Google translation.

18. Could you please provide the list of business requirements? Please see Appendix A.

19.In terms of communication, should the system contain a chart or forum, or only email? What are the specific features of the communication tool that you would like to have included? The mass communication notification system should be able to communicate using a variety of platforms: email, voice, text, and through an app.

20.Should a new solution allow the users to register a child for school online? If yes, please illuminate the process and third-party services (if any) that should be involved. Shall we

implement any interactive forms feature to support the registration process? Online registration is managed through the NSD student database, Follett Aspen X2.

21.Is it correct that the new branding and visual look (UI) for the website should be created considering staying with the current logotype? Shall we also come up with the design guidelines for the District? If yes, is it allowed to extend the timeline for design activities? The current logo stands and the new visual look for the website should include the current logo.

22.Do you want to keep Follet Aspen integration or develop/integrate with some other solution? Would you, please, list down all external services that are currently in use together with the web-portal that is a subject of the redesign? We are keeping the NSD student database with Follett Aspen X2.

23.What are the additional features available for logged in users? How do you manage user accounts at the moment? Is logging-in feature a part of the given project scope? The parent/family portal is managed through Follett Aspen X2.

24. Would you like to have any LMS (Learning Management System) features implemented within the scope of the project? No thank you.
