

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

The Board encourages the use of community resources and citizens to assist in furthering the educational program. The Board encourages each Principal to study the needs of his or her individual school and survey the resources available in the school community. This policy relative to partnerships among schools, families, and communities shall comply with the following standards:

- (1) Involving parents and family members of students of all ages and learning levels;
- (2) Providing parent educational activities throughout the school year to help parents support their children's learning;
- (3) Communicating school performance, student progress, personalized learning strategies as adopted by the local school board and in accordance with district and graduation competencies, and academic opportunities, using both print and online formats;
- (4) Working with agencies and businesses to support community-based developmental activities that prepare young children for school and promote ongoing achievement;
- (5) Promoting collaboration among parents, schools, and community on school improvement and student achievement projects;
- (6) Striving to harness all available community resources, including but not limited to organizations, businesses, talented individuals, natural resources, and technology, to engage each student in achieving necessary skills and knowledge; and
- (7) Encouraging business partnerships to assist students in the successful transition to employment or further education.

All use of community resources will conform to policies of the Board, as implemented by the Superintendent and staff.
