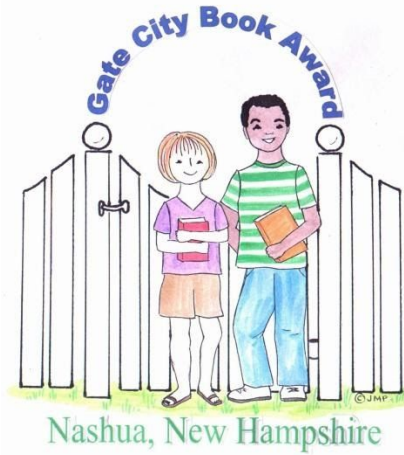


# Gate City Book Award Nominees
